

1. BACKGROUND

The Government of Liberia through the National Investment Commission has received funding from the African Development Bank (AfDB) for the preparation and implementation of the Special Agro-Industrial Processing Zone (SAPZ) Project. The Project Development Objective is to facilitate poverty reduction through economic growth and sustainable value-added agricultural development in Liberia. The Project aims to reduce the unemployment gap/rate, decrease staple food imports, provide the required infrastructure, and enable an economic environment for the expansion of the private sector investment in the agriculture and Agro-industry.

The proposed Special Economic Zone is located in the City of Buchanan, the capital of Grand Bassa County. The SAPZ project will utilize 200 ha of the designated Special Economic Zone (631 ha) land space situated in Buchanan, Grand Bassa County. The proposed sites for the construction and operation of the Agricultural Transformation Centers (ATCs) include Madina, Grand Cape Mount, Gbartala, Bong and Saclepea, Nimba County, respectively.

3. AUDIT OBJECTIVE

The primary objective of the environmental audit consultancy is to carry out an environmental assessment of the project area; determine the potential impacts and their mitigation measures, in compliance with EPA's national environmental legislation and standards, enforce compliance, and ensure environmental sustainability and protection of human health.

- Conduct public consultations to be termed as scoping to identify, inform, and receive input from affected stakeholders and interested parties at project sites and project sub-activities communities, and propose mitigation measures to address these impacts; All consultations and stakeholder engagements in the field visit to ensure equitable engagement of males
- Assess the physical, biological, and environmental baseline of the project environment and identify the potential risks associated with the project implementation;
- Conduct field visit to water bodies, forests, and soil to determine potential impacts and mitigation measures during project implementation on all sub-project activities;
- Conduct a demographic survey to determine the number of existing farm and agricultural fields within the project areas, and the proposed 4.27km linked road, & transmission line corridor;
- Collaborate actively with the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Ministry of Agriculture (MOA), and other line ministries and agencies that operate within the project areas/site; etc.
- Used GPS coordinate to Geo-map all project sites required and develop a map indicating the project areas of intervention; and

4. SCOPE OF SERVICES:

- 1. Conduct and prioritize high-impact activities in the project sites, which will;
- a. Determine every aspect of the project activities in the developmental stages; medium impact activities in the road intervention, which shall cover other activities in rice, oil palm, cocoa, and other crops; and
- The assessment should focus on the agriculture impacts, road construction impacts, and the invention of smallholders to be highly considered; cocoa and vegetables shall be considered; smallholder farmers and wastewater treatment shall be considered.
- Conduct an Environmental Survey of the project sites:
- a. Describe the Social environment (sociocultural characteristics; various communities cultural beliefs/practices, occupation, means of livelihood, settlement pattern, gender issues, etc.) of the project area;
- b. Identify various areas of potential environmental impacts with a complete environmental assessment
- c. The EPA laws under Part III, provide specific measures in complying with the requirement established under section (25) of the EPML shall in consultation with the relevant Line Ministry, be responsible for carrying out periodic environmental audits of activities or projects that are likely to have adverse effects on the environment.

The National Investment Commission/Special Agro-Industrial Processing Zone and the Environmental Protection Agency will notify the various stakeholders that there is a consultancy that has been commissioned to conduct the audit. The fullest cooperation of the stakeholders and the communities will be solicited.

Consultancy will set up a team leader or lead auditor who will be appointed based on his knowledge and expertise. All activities will be organized with respect to a work schedule for conducting documentation review, on-site audit and report submission, to be reviewed and approved by the EPA and the NIC/SAPZ.

The audit will focus on specific environmental issues relating to the site being audited, which will be prepared and submitted to the Environmental Protection Agency for review and approval. The checklist covers environmental issues which include:

S/Court ruling should change the "chaotic trend" in Liberia

he Supreme Court of Liberia recently described the ongoing leadership crisis in the House of Representatives as a "chaotic trend" in Liberia that needs to needs to be reversed. We couldn't have agreed with the High Court any

Despite the presence of the legitimate Speaker of the House, a group of lawmakers, referring to themselves as Majority Bloc gathered and elected Montserrado County Sistrict#11 Representative, Richard Nagbe Koon, of the ruling Unity Party as Speaker. This action was done outside the Constitution of the Republic of Liberia.

Though illegal, their action is being backed by the Executive that | has interpreted in its favor, an earlier Supreme Court opinion that noted that actions taken at the House were ultra vires, contrarily inducting Representative Koon in office as Speaker in spite of the presence of embattled Speaker J. Fonati Koffa.

Ultra vires is a Latin phrase that is used in law to describe an act that requires legal authority but is done without it.

Speaker Koffa has challenged his illegal removal before the Supreme Court twice, with the recent being a Bill of Information, at which hearing the Court sounded the early warning about 'chaotic trend" in the governing system of the country.

The regional bloc, ECOWAS, thru its parliamentary body has tried | twice in intervening to salvage the impasse without succeeding | largely as a result of non-cooperative posture by members of the so-called majority bloc.

In their obsession with power, they have gone to the extent of writing the ECOWAS Parliament, requesting withdrawal of three Liberian Representatives who were sent to that body under the Koffa leadership. But the Parliament trend the request down because it contravenes its rules.

La décision de la Cour suprême doit inverser la tendance chaotique au Liberia

a Cour suprême du Liberia a récemment qualifié la crise de leadership en cours à la Chambre des représentants de "tendance chaotique" qui doit être corrigée. Nous ne saurions être plus en accord avec cette déclaration de la plus haute juridiction du pays.

Malgré la présence d'un président légitime à la Chambre, un groupe de députés se faisant appeler le "Bloc majoritaire" s'est réuni et a élu Richard Nagbe Koon, représentant du district #11 de Montserrado et membre du parti au pouvoir, l'Unity Party, comme président de la Chambre. Cette démarche a été menée en dehors du cadre constitutionnel du Liberia.

Bien que cette action soit illégale, elle a bénéficié du soutien de l'exécutif, qui a interprété à son avantage un avis précédent de la Cour suprême. Cet avis indiquait que les décisions prises à la Chambre étaient "ultra vires", c'est-àdire prises sans autorité légale. Cependant, au lieu de corriger cette situation, l'exécutif a permis l'induction du représentant Koon en tant que président de la Chambre, en dépit de la présence du président contesté J. Fonati Koffa.

Le président Koffa a contesté son limogeage illégal à deux reprises devant la Cour suprême, la plus récente étant une requête en information. Lors de cette audience, la Cour a mis en garde contre la "tendance chaotique" qui affecte le système de gouvernance du pays.

La Communauté économique des États de l'Afrique de l'Ouest (CEDEAO), à travers son organe parlementaire, a tenté par deux fois d'intervenir pour résoudre cette impasse. Cependant, ces efforts ont échoué en grande partie en raison de l'attitude non coopérative des membres du soi-disant "Bloc majoritaire".

Dans leur quête du pouvoir, ces députés sont allés jusqu"à demander au Parlement de la CEDEAO le retrait de trois représentants libériens désignés sous la direction de Koffa. Toutefois, cette demande a été rejetée car contraire aux règlements de l'institution.

Nous sommes convaincus qu'aucune institution, en dehors de la Cour suprême, ne peut régler cette violation flagrante de la Constitution du Liberia. En tant que seule instance habilitée à interpréter les lois du pays, elle doit user de son autorité pour clarifier la situation sans ambiguïté et rétablir l'ordre constitutionnel.

Lors de sa dernière prise de parole sur cette affaire, la Cour suprême a laissé le public dans l'incertitude, une situation qui a été exploitée par l'exécutif pour justifier ses actions.

Cette fois-ci, nous exhortons la plus haute juridiction du pays à se prononcer avec fermeté et clarté sur cette affaire, en se fondant uniquement sur le droit. Il est essentiel que la Cour détermine de manière décisive quelle partie est dans son tort, afin que le peuple libérien puisse comprendre la loi et agir en conséquence.

Dismissed LPRC employees demand S/Court's ruling

According to the group, constant delay by the Court to hand down ruling in a case that has spent seven years before it and has lingered in the corridor of the



Liberia Petroleum Refining Company (LPRC) is upset with the Supreme Court of Liberia for delay in rendering judgement in their complaint before the Court despite two recessive hearings.

The aggrieved former employees on Tuesday, April 1, 2025, petitioned the Supreme Court through a written communication to Chief Justice, Her Honor, Sie-A-Nyene Gyapay Yuoh, expressing disappointment and frustration over delay in handing down ruling in the case between the downsized employees and the Management of the LPRC.

Judiciary for approximately nineteen years, is an attempt to deny them justice, noting that justice delayed, is justice denied. They argued that after series of pre-trial conferences before Labour Court Judge, Her Honour, Comfort Natt, dismissed the case in favour of LPRC, thus prompting them to petition the Supreme Court of Liberia for JUDICIAL REVIEW.

Following their petition to the High Court in its October Team 2018, under the leadership of former Chief Justice Francis S. Korkpor, Sr, first argument was heard on 17th December 2018, but ruling was reserved. Also, in its March Term A.D. 2023, the

Supreme Court, under Her Honour, Sie-A-Nyene G. Yuoh, heard the 2nd argument and ruling was also reserved.

The affected employees lament that because of the protracted delay to give ruling in the case, 92 of their fellow aggrieved compatriots have died out of stress and frustration, thus leaving behind their families in a state of perpetual hopelessness

"Moving forward, we wish to outrightly call upon the Honorable Supreme Court of Liberia to stand the high moral ground to release the ruling in our case, as justice delayed is justice denied", they noted in their communication. In 2006, during the Administration of former President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf, the Management of the Liberia Petroleum Refining Company (LPRC) executed what it termed as a "rightsizing plan" to reduce its workforce of 750 to approximately 250 employees. This action by the government led to more than 400 employees of the Company losing their means of income. They allege that shortly after the redundancy exercise carried out by the Company, more people were recruited and employed, something, which they believe, was politically-motivated and wrongful dismissal. "We the affected LPRC redundant employees of 2006 subsequently filed a formal complaint before the Labour Court of Liberia on April 27, 2009, against the Management of LPRC, alleging unfair labour practices and wrongful dismissal." their relevance and effectiveness in addressing evolving needs of Liberia's Minister for Fiscal Affairs financial system. He emphasizes key issues that will guide the review of the 2024-2027 PFM Strategy and Action Plans. Myers notes that discussions will tackle challenges related to budget preparation, approval processes, and execution, including budgetary transfers, as well as application of various revenue laws. The Ministry of Finance, in collaboration with the International Monetary Fund (IMF), has been working on the development of a comprehensive PFM Strategy & Action Plan for 2024-2027. The strategy, which was officially endorsed by the Cabinet on September 13, 2024, is designed to drive significant reforms aimed at improving Liberia's financial management systems. As implementation progresses, some activities within the PFM

Action Plan are already underway, while others are in planning stages, set to begin shortly."This workshop forms a critical part of the Ministry's ongoing efforts to assess progress, overcome challenges and ensure the successful execution of the strategy. A focal point of the technical sessions will be on essential components of the PFM Strategy, particularly the Budget Transfer Law and the Amended and Restated PFM Act of 2019.
